

#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

When we began this project, I found myself returning to *Frankenstein* not as a story of science, but as a story of survival. In Shelley's novel, creation is an act of desperation— of loneliness, of loss, of the need to make meaning in a collapsing world. That idea felt urgent to me. We live in an age where humanity wrestles with its own creations—technological, ecological, even moral—and like Victor Frankenstein, we are haunted by what we have made. Especially since Shelley wrote her novel after just having lost a child herself, this adaptation asks: what happens when creation is no longer an act of progress, but of grief?

Coming from the Caucasus, from Georgia—a place of mountains, fire, and myth—I wanted to root Frankenstein in something older and more elemental. Prometheus, the bringer of fire, was one of our first stories, and Shelley herself invoked him in her title. In this version, I wanted to bring those myths full circle: to set Shelley's creation myth against the raw landscapes of ice and stone, where human endurance itself feels like an act of rebellion. Here, science becomes ritual, and resurrection becomes dance. It's a dialogue between ancient and future worlds, between the myth of Prometheus and the story of Frankenstein each warning us of the same truth: that creation always demands a price.

As always, this piece is the result of many hands, hearts, and imaginations. To the performers who gave their bodies to the movement, to the designers who built worlds from fire and shadow, and to the collaborators who kept faith through every storm—thank you. You have given this story its pulse, its breath, and its life.



#### **SYNOPSIS**

In a desolate, frozen future, Prometheus, his wife Gaia, and a band of survivors scratch an existence in a ruined world. When a violent storm destroys what little they have, Gaia is blinded and her and Prometheus' child is killed. Grief-stricken, Prometheus discovers fire atop a mountain and learns to master it. Returning to the others, he uses its power to create a new being: the Creature. But the creation turns against its maker and escapes into the wild, where it begins to grow, learn, and evolve on its own.


As the Creature gains strength and self-awareness, it returns to find Gaia and Prometheus. Drawn to Gaia's tenderness, the Creature kills her in a tragic, confused act of love. Prometheus, consumed by rage and loss, tries once more to resurrect her, but this time she awakens changed—alive yet aligned with the Creature. Together they overthrow Prometheus, leaving him broken and alone as they disappear into the wasteland. The story ends where it began, in ice and silence, with humanity's last creator facing the ruin his own hands have made.






